

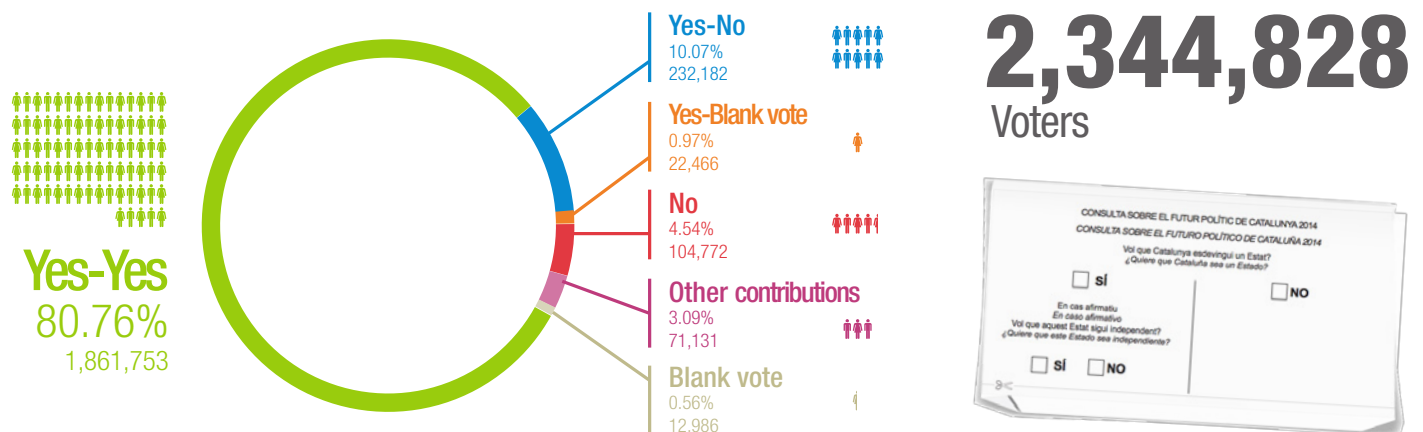


The 9-N participative process was held in Catalonia as a result of the State's constant denial to accept any form of referendum offered by the Generalitat

Pro-consultation parties held 87 of the 135 seats in Parliament


According to official opinion polls (CEO), 70.8% of Catalans approved the convening of the consultation



The only response by the State has been to initiate a legal proceeding against President Mas, Minister Rigau and former Vice-President Ortega
