The new metro line is entirely automatic and connects **Barcelona** with **L'Hospitalet de Llobregat** and **El Prat de Llobregat**.

It also connects strategic other locations, such as the **Parc Logístic**, **Mercabarna** and **Mas Blau**.



Fira Barcelona

Providing a direct connection to and from the airport and city centre, the metro line will add greater value to the **Montjuïc 2 exhibition centre**.

T1 — 🚆 — **T2**

The new line connects the airport's two terminals.

At **T1**, the metro stops inside the terminal, while at **T2** it stops next to the railway station.

The Government of Catalonia, in coordination with Barcelona's City Hall, has announced its intention **to finish the L10 by 2017**, connecting the Marina and Zona Franca neighbourhoods.
