



Catalonia broke its own record in 2018, with medical teams performing **1,149 transplants**

According to data from the Catalan Transplant Organisation (OCATT)



This rate is above **150 per million population** (151.2) a level achieved by few countries and regions of the world

- **New record set for lung transplants:** over 100 transplants were performed – a total of 104 in a single year
- **71 heart transplants** in 2018, a new historic high




Second best year ever for organ donations in Catalonia: 328 suitable deceased donors

- **8 out of 10 families of potential donors gave consent** for donation of their family member's organs



New record for paediatric transplants in Catalonia

Vall d'Hebron Mother and Child Hospital and Sant Joan de Déu Hospital performed **53 transplants**

 25 kidney

 15 liver

 8 heart

 5 lung



For nearly **1 of every 3 minors** who received transplants in Spain, the procedure was performed at one of Catalonia's two paediatric centres
